FLOAT AND TROOP APPLICATION

RULES AND PROCEDURES FOR ALL ENTIES

1.DISRUPTIVE PARTICIPANTS;

The St Croix St.Patrick's Day Parade Committee reserves the right to bar or remove from the Parade any entry which refuses to follow all instructions from Parade pacers, parade officials, The St.Patrick's Day Parade Committee staff and / or Police

2.SPECTATOR SAFETY;

No solicitation literature, toy guns or other materials may be handed out or thrown along the parade route Water & only water can be sprayed along the Parade Route.....**Please do not encourage spectators to enter the parade path for any reason!**

3.POSSESSION OF ILLEGAL DRUGS;

The Possession of any illegal substance is strictly prohibited any where through out the Parade Route, on any person or on any float or vehicle taking part in the Parade.

4.EXCESSIVE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

Please stay in control of alcohol consumption.Remember you are responsible for your float and your peoples safety.

5.PACING;

Spacing between each unit will be enforced by Parade Officials.

A unit will be required to close the gap between itself and the preceding unit when directed by Parade Officials. Each Units appointed Captain shall pace the Unit and work with the Parade Pacers.

6.“NO SHOWS “

Any entrée which fails to appear for the Parade without first notifying the Parade Committee, or any entree which does not comply with all the rules, will jeopardize future Participation in St Patrick's Day Parades.

7. SIGNAGE;

Use of political signs or other political material is prohibited on any entrée or around the Parade route. In addition, any controversial statements or pictures on your unit will be reviewed for acceptance prior to the Parade by Parade Officials.

8.IDENTIFACATION;

All entrees in the Parade must have identification. It must appear on a tasteful banner preceding a unit or on the front of a float.Acarried banner should be weighted at the bottom and contain slashes to permit air flow.

FLOAT AND TROOP APPLICATION

9.PARADE NUMBERS

All entrees in the Parade shall be given a number. They are to be placed on front right and/or left front of a entree. This includes walking or individual entrees. All numbers must be visible for the Judges to see.

10.PARADE TIME;

All participants in the Parade should be in the start area at least one half hour prior to the start of the Parade.
